Taxes

We are partnering with AARP, to provide tax preparation appointments once again. Due to covid-19 restrictions, clients will not be permitted to sit at the table while their tax paperwork is being completed. Clients will be able to sit in a designated waiting area, or in their vehicles during the appointment. Appointments will be held on Mondays from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 pm, starting on February 7th. Upon arrival, it is necessary for the clients' tax packet to be filled out completely. These packets may be picked up when you schedule an appointment at the senior center. The following items are needed to be present during the appointment, In order for your taxes to be completed:

- Social Security card
- photo ID
- last year's taxes
- The 6475 form if you received a stimulus payment.
