

**PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD  
MINUTES OF MEETING HELD AUGUST 5, 2009**

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The Parks and Recreation Board met in regular session on August 5, 2009 at 7:00 p.m. in the Veteran's Memorial Park Depot, West Warren Street, Germantown, Ohio.

**MEMBERS PRESENT:**

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

Mrs. Shyrigh moved to approve the July 1, 2009 minutes as amended, the July 11, 2009 minutes as amended, and the July 15, 2009 minutes as presented, second by Mr. Rhoades.

Mr. Engler stated he would like to see the seeding work done by September 1<sup>st</sup> and will be getting quotes.

Discussion then took place on the vandalism that has been done in the parks.

Mr. Engler thanked the Fire Department for burning the brush pile.

Mrs. Shyrigh stated she was talking to a man who stated he played disc golf when he was a kid and she did not realize that disc golf has been around for a long time.

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Mr. Neff thanked everyone for their help on July 4<sup>th</sup>. He added that he almost put something together for August 1<sup>st</sup> but there was a conflict with the Historical Society Style Show and Spaghetti Dinner.

Mr. Engler suggested moving more tables into the park next year so there is more area for eating.

Mr. Rhoades questioned when the park closes with a brief discussion following regarding a set time to close the park and the need for more police enforcement.

Mr. Neff stated that he was reimbursed for the items obtained for the parade and he will be giving a flag to each one of the churches that was honored as Grand Marshal.

Mrs. Shyrigh then discussed the Pretzel Festival and the request that the edge of the booths be moved six feet back from the sidewalk. Annie will contact the committee.

**VILLAGE MANAGER'S REPORT:**

Mrs. Sizemore discussed the repairs that need to be done to the stage.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

Discussion continued on the need for increased patrol at the parks in order to help stop the vandalism.
