

**FIRE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE  
MINUTES OF MEETING HELD APRIL 19, 2010**

The Fire Oversight Committee met in regular session on April 19, 2010 at 5:36 p.m. in the Municipal Building Council Chambers. The meeting was chaired by Mr. Benson.

**ROLL CALL:**

The following members were present at the Call to Order: Scott Anding, Randy Benson, Ron Comer, Michael Kuhn and Richard Pettit.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

Mr. Benson moved to accept the April 5, 2010 minutes as submitted, second by Mr. Comer.

ROLL CALL: Mr. Benson, yes; Mr. Comer, yes; Mr. Kuhn, abstain; Mr. Pettit, yes; Mr. Anding, abstain. 3-yes, 2- abstentions. MOTION CARRIED.

**VILLAGE MANAGER'S REPORT:**

Mrs. Sizemore stated that the voting places have changed in the Village and the Township. She contacted the Board of Elections and there are only three places and they are the High School, Germantown Church of the Nazarene and the Germantown United Methodist Church. They have consolidated the voting locations as a cost saving measure. They said that everyone received a notice and they will post a sign at the old locations the day of the election directing them to their new location.

She went on by saying that we have had an issue with the levy signs. We are asking the levy signs be removed from the right-of-way. The Village did not remove any signs, they simply moved them back out of the right-of-way.

**FIRE CHIEF'S REPORT:**

Chief Alldred stated that they have placed 130 levy signs and have 60 more left. Please let him know if anyone needs a levy signs.

A brief discussion took place regarding the articles.

Chief Alldred then reviewed the May 2010 levy activities.

**OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE MEMBER'S REPORTS:**

Mr. Benson stated that the Township has placed their large sign in front of the Township building showing support for the upcoming levy. They are able to have the sign out there until the election since they are no longer a voting location.

Mr. Comer stated that Chief Alldred and Mr. Anding did a nice job on the articles and getting the levy information out to the residents. He thanked them for their hard work.

Mr. Kuhn questioned Chief Alldred if he had ordered door hangers; Chief Alldred replied that he had not.

Chief Alldred stated that he was not sure he would have the personnel to hang door hangers

Mr. Kuhn stated that he and Mr. Wafzig were going to do Hillcrest, and if Chief Alldred would like to do the door hangers they would use them.

Chief Alldred stated that he would have to clear his other costs and see if the budget would allow him to print door hangers.

Mrs. Sizemore questioned if we would be able to get them copies of the flyers and have them deliver information to the Hillcrest residents, Chief Alldred replied that he had plenty of yellow paper to make extra copies if they would like to deliver the flyers.

Mr. Pettit stated that the article in the Dayton Daily News on Sunday was a very good write up and we need to be proud of our new medic. It is really something.

All agreed to have the next meeting on May 3rd.
