BUSINESS:

Mike Hafner – TEC Engineering – Cherry Street Speed Limit Discussion

Mr. Hafner, Staff and Council discussed the possibility of changing the speed limit on Cherry Street. He explained the consequences, by doing so, it could change the ability to receive funding to make further improvements. He would check into various options and return to council.

Memorial Bench Program

RV and Recreational Vehicle Discussion

Food Truck Discussion

Staff and Council discussed food trucks and what we currently allow. We want to make changes to the current code to be more flexible. Staff will look at surrounding communities and see what they allow, what they charge and their applications.
